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Dear Parents,

Inflected Endings

In word study this week, we are practicing words that have the inflected endings 'ed' and 'ing.' We will learn when to double the final consonant when adding the ending, as in drop-dropping, when to drop the 'e', as in smile-smiling, and when to simply add the ending and not change the word at all, as in talk-talked. Please review rules for adding inflected endings with your child this week. C=consonant, V=vowel

Do not change the word when the end of the word has a VCC at the end: talk-talked

<u>Double the last letter of the word when the word ends with CVC and the vowel is</u>
<u>short: drop - dropping</u>

For long vowel words with the 'super e' drop the 'e' to add 'ed' and 'ing': smile – smiled and smiling

Students should study the 10 assigned pattern words below and the 5 high frequency words for the spelling test on Friday. On the final test, there will be an additional 10 words that contain inflected endings as well (for a total of 25 words). Students are not expected to study those words ahead of time. They will apply their knowledge of inflected ending rules to NEW words. Please assist your child in preparing for the test by making sure he or she completes the attached word study homework packet.
